ADJUSTMENT OF STORAGE SCALES FOR TRANSHIPMENT FULL CONTAINERS

Kenya Ports Authority wishes to announce to Shipping Lines and Agents the *Adjustment of Storage Scales* for Transshipment Containerized Cargo handled at the Port of Mombasa. This is aimed at simplifying the storage regime, easing tariff interpretation and making the Port a competitive transshipment hub serving the maritime industry.

Therefore, the *Storage Scales* used to compute storage charges have been reduced from three scales to one as follows:

		<u>RATE IN USD PER DAY OR PART THEREOF</u>	
Clause 16.14	Transshipment Full Containers	<u>20'</u>	<u>40'</u>
	- First 15 consecutive days	Free	Free
	- Thereafter, up to the date the container is re-shipped	20.00	40.00

The storage charges for Empty Transshipment Containers remain as per Clause 16.15 of the Tariff.

Furthermore, KPA is offering extension of Storage Free Period for Transshipment Containerized cargo **upon request by individual shipping lines giving volume commitments** aimed at promoting transshipment traffic. As such, shipping lines wishing to benefit from this volume-based tariff incentive are required to make formal application for consideration.

This takes effect on **2nd April 2024** and supersedes any other notice issued earlier on the subject matter.
