PUBLIC NOTICE ON IMPLEMENTATION OF LEGAL NOTICE 127

The Kenya Bureau of Standards (KEBS) pursuant to the publication of the Legal Notice No. 127 of the Standards Acts, Cap. 496 on 19th June 2018, hereby notifies the general public that all imported goods destined to Kenya shall be required to undergo mandatory inspection in the country of origin or supply prior to shipment into the country. Importers and the general public are informed that goods loaded on or after 1st October 2018 will be expected to fully comply with the provision of the Legal Notice.

The KEBS appointed inspection agents shall inspect such goods and issue Certificate of Conformity (CoC) / Certificate of Roadworthiness (CoR) in respect to goods / motor vehicles that conform to the relevant Kenyan standards or approved specifications.

THE STANDARDS (INSPECTION OF IMPORTS) ORDER, 2018

We refer to the above subject matter.

We are notified that following the publication of Legal Notice No. 127 of 19th June, 2018 revoking Legal Notice No. 78 of 15th July, 2005; all imports consigned to a Port of Entry in Kenya are required to undergo Pre-Shipment Verification and be issued with the requisite Certificate of Conformity, beginning from 15th September, 2018. This position was communicated to the general public vide a joint Public Notice by the Kenya Revenue Authority and the Kenya Bureau of Standards.

Following our Meeting of 5th September, 2018, it was resolved that there was need to allow all the players within the value-chain sufficient time to put in place the measures necessary for full compliance. In this regard, it was agreed that the transition period be extended by two weeks, to at least 1st October, 2018.
