



## **NOTICE TO PORT STAKEHOLDERS**

This is to advise all port stakeholders that as part of the ongoing measures to reduce cargo backlog at the Port, KPA will effective from today, transfer empty containers to a number of CFS yards. These containers arrived via the SGR but have remained uncollected so far. KPA has waived storage charges due on these containers. Importers will, however, pay a handling & transfer fee of **US\$75** for a 20ft container and **US\$100** for a 40ft container, subject to 7 days free period at the CFS. The CFS operators will work with ships agents to identify the parties to whom they were released so that they may go and collect them and complete the container cycle. This measure has been necessitated by the fact that the existing empty container depots are full. The move will also help in streamlining the process of return of empty containers via the SGR so that empties can be picked with ease. The list of containers and the CFSs to which they have been transferred will be made available daily in our website [www.kpa.co.ke](http://www.kpa.co.ke)
